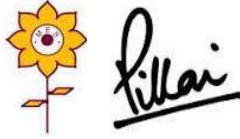
- Post lunch proceed for full day sightseeing and sketching at Hampi.

Hampi is the town of ruins of Vijayanagara Empire. It is one of the UNESCO recognized world heritage sites in India. This place is one of India's most known archaeological destinations. Badami is known to be the perfect example of excellent Indian rock cut architecture. The temple is built out of red sandstone and is one of the most ancient temples of the country.

Students would get an opportunity to do settlement and topography study of the landscape. They would get a chance to see the influence of different rulers who ruled India in the architectural monuments at all these sites, such as Vijayanagara style of Architecture in Hampi, the Chalukyan influence in Badami and Islamic Architecture in Bijapur.
