Day 2: Arrival at Jaipur. Students Visited City palace, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal after which the students were allowed to explore Jaipur Market

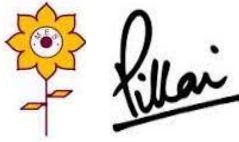
Day 5: Arrival at Jaisalmer. They visit Bada Bagh and Gadiar Lake where they were given free time to explore.

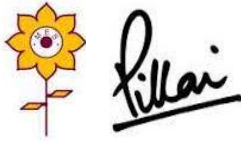

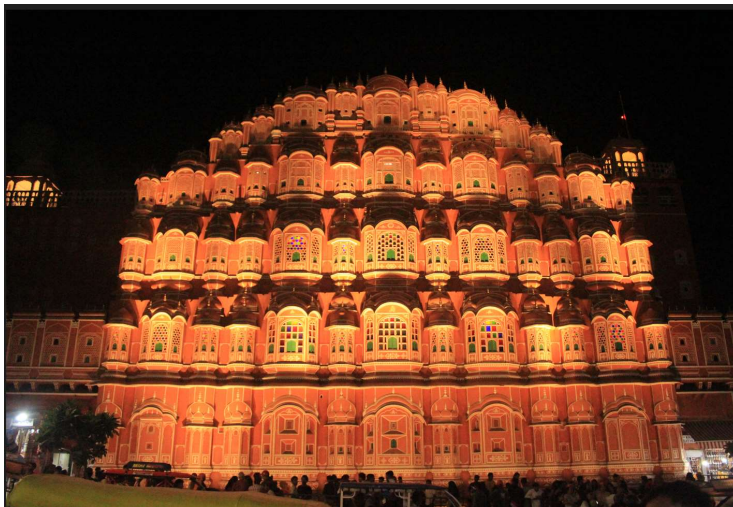
