Preamble-

Historic architecture has always been a highly debated and largely neglected domain in architectural education. It results in a disconnect with our cultural past in architectural practices. A close inspection of the architectural practices in India reveals that many of our post-independence Indian masters owe their success to their rootedness in our past. Scholars today recommend study of historic architecture for creation of culturally responsive sustainable architecture. Architectural history is no more a discipline rooted in style and periods but is a repository of our traditional knowledge. Postcolonial theories highlight the disconnect with our cultural past. Thus, we need to review our theoretical position on historic architecture in keeping with various emerging theories. Large number of scholars have done pioneering research about Indian architecture in recent times.

Are our architectural history teachers aware of this and trained for this? Are they aware of the nuances of 'history' as a discipline? Architectural History is a very specialized domain that evolved from art history and has its own set of pedagogical challenges that need to be addressed. When oriental philosophy is strongly emerging in heritage conservation practices as a school, architects at large are still ignorant about the subtleties of the same.

This training program offers an opportunity to learn about the history as a subject, philosophical stances related to history, introduction to new approaches for understanding history. Exclusive sessions on different phases of Indian history by experts from Indology, archaeology and architecture are planned to give new insights into each phase along with pedagogical knowledge and technical innovations to enrich the capabilities of the history teacher.

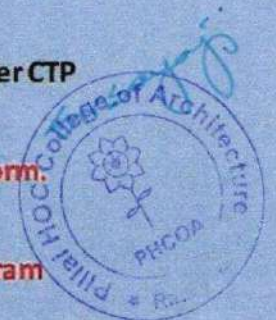

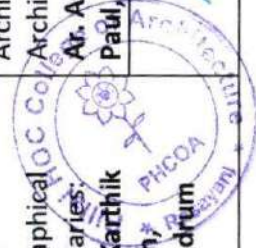

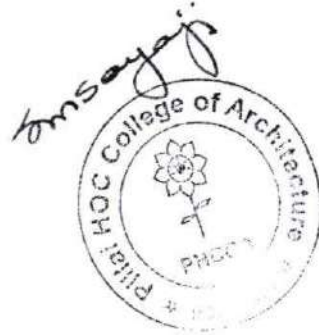

PROJECT: Capacity Building for Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation with a Special Focus on Sustainable Habitat and Risk Management

THE PROJECT

The project aims to build capacity by imparting training on "Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation" with focus on various components like sustainable habitat, green building, disaster risk reduction and management, and socio-economic vulnerability and livelihood. Under this project, VNIT Nagpur will be conducting ten training courses during 2017-20.

ABOUT THE COURSE

"The more governments, UN agencies, organizations, businesses and civil society understand risk and vulnerability the better equipped they will be to mitigate disasters when they strike and save more lives" -Ban Ki-moon, United Nations Secretary-General. Extreme events are events that have extreme values of certain important meteorological variables. Damage is often caused by extreme values of certain meteorological variables such as large amounts of precipitation (e.g., floods), high wind speeds (e.g., cyclones), high temperatures (e.g., heat waves), sudden and violent shaking (Earthquakes) etc. A disaster is a sudden, calamitous event that seriously disrupts the functioning of a community or society and causes human, material and economic or environmental losses that exceed the community's or society's ability to cope using its own resources. Though often caused by nature, disasters can have human origins. The National Disaster Management Plan of India incorporates substantially the approach enunciated in the Sendai Framework and aims to make India disaster resilient, achieve substantial disaster risk reduction, and significantly decrease the losses of life, livelihoods, and assets - economic, physical, social, cultural, and environmental- by maximizing the ability to cope with disasters at all levels of administration as well as among communities. This course aims at addressing the concerns of NDMA and training the stake holders.

It focuses on 1) Geophysically triggered disasters like earthquake, Tsunami, Landslide; 2) Extreme events like Heat Wave, Cyclone, Urban Floods, etc. and 3) building fire; Each unit will focus on understanding the fundamentals of extreme events / disaster, related risk and possible mitigation and adaptation methods with respect to human settlements.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The course is designed for practising architects, civil engineers, structural engineers (private and public sectors), officials in SDMA, DDMA, NDMA, Urban local bodies, Zilla Parishad, Town Planning authority, Real Estate Developers etc. The participants are recommended to bring their laptop for hands-on training sessions.

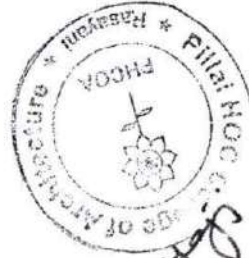

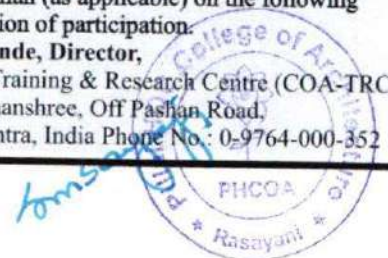

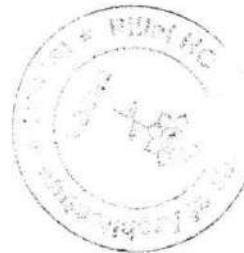

Revisiting pedagogical objectives of a Design Jury

PREAMBLE

The design jury, design critique, or crit is a common teaching and learning strategy within art, design, and architecture education. It dates back to the nineteenth century Beaux-Arts school of architecture education and has since evolved into a variety of different formats within architectural education. The aim of the design crit is to provide oral formative or summative feedback, depending on when the crit occurs in relation to the design exercise, and to prepare the students for their careers as professional designers presenting their designs to clients.

There are criticisms on the process of crit as being more negative and not comprehending to heighten the learning atmosphere for student anxiety, students' inability to learn from the feedback, power asymmetry between student and faculty or privileging professional acculturation over student learning. Yet it is universally accepted that Design crit is a distinguishing factor of education so, there arises a need to relook into various methods and techniques of conducting a constructive crit.

The five day programme would look out to explore various components of a design crit focussing on the learning objectives and outcomes of the level of the design education, studio brief and expected quality of work from the students, relevance of the crit and take away from the comments given, ways to incorporate the jury comments into furthering the design process. The discussions would focus on the crit environs like timing, participants, audience, feedback, purpose, language and location. ET all, the programme would conclude with finding ways to device the process of crit as a conducive method of design pedagogy.

WHEN ? Planning and scheduling Crits during the design process, Methods of conducting Crit/ Jury

WHAT ? Expectations of a Jury panel and preparing students to address them, Submission requirements, standard of work, Quantitative and qualitative assessment of Architectural works

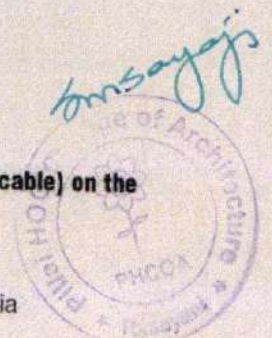
