(i) The candidate should be a citizen of India; (ii) The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% marks (at least 40% marks for candidates from Reserved Categories, Economically Weaker Section and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in aggregate; OR (iii) The candidate should have passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% marks (at least 40% for candidates from Reserved Categories, Economically Weaker Section and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in aggregate; (iv) The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or NATA conducted by the Council of Architecture; (v) Any other criterion declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.
